

Lava Flow Scarf

This scarf was created to have a front and back that are equally attractive. The simple pattern, a mix of seed stitch and stockinette, shows off hand paints and specialty yarns like the Patty boucle. It doesn't curl and is an easy one skein project.

1 sk Schaeffer Patty (200y) Elena Piscopia colorway or any light worsted. Finer gauge yarns will make a narrower scarf.

Gauge: 4.5 stitches to the inch on #10 needles (but doesn't really matter).

Creates a 6"x45" scarf

Cast on 29 stitches.

Row 1 *K1, P1* Repeat from * 2 times, K4, *K1, P1* Repeat from * 2 times, K4, *K1, P1* Repeat from * 2 times, K1

Row 2 K1, P1, K1, P1, K2, P4, K2, P1, K1, P1, K2, P4, K2, P1, K1, P1, K1

Repeat these rows for pattern to desired length
